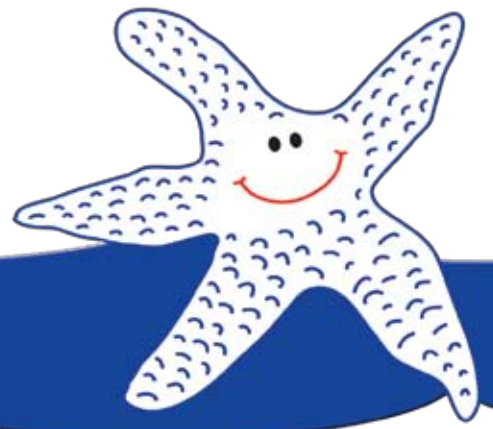

## Crickets In The Can

### What You Will Need:

- \* Five 3 inch squares of paper (each player will need five)
- \* Tape
- \* A clean can with a lid. Not too tall of a can.
- \* Construction paper (to cover the outside of your can)



### How To Make:

1. Make sure your can and lid are clean. Cover the can with construction paper and decorate it.
2. To make your crickets, fold the 3-inch squares of paper in half three times. See step 2 example.
3. Wrap a piece of tape around each end of the folded paper. See step 3 example.
4. Fold the paper into a W shape. See step 4 example.
5. Make five crickets for each player. Each player will need a different color.

### How To Play Jumping Crickets:

The object of the game is to get the most crickets into the can. On a flat surface and with the taped ends facing you, squash down the W with your finger or thumb, then release it. This will let the cricket jump. Aim for the can. You can play this alone or compete with a friend. You can compete with more than one friend. Get your friends together and have some fun playing Jumping Crickets.

## Starfish Facts
